Job Description

REPORTS TO AND IS SUPPORTED BY:

Director of Music

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

The Pianist works with the Director of Music, the Minister, and other worship staff and volunteers to organize and provide music for the worship program for weekly services.

WORK SCHEDULE:

The Pianist is expected to participate in Sunday services and scheduled choir practices. Most other duties, including practice, may be performed at times and locations convenient for the Pianist.

ILLUSTRATIVE TASKS:

Under the supervision of the Director of Music

- Supports the vision, mission, ministry, and core values of the congregation,
- Accompanies the hymns and worship songs,
- Accompanies the choir under the supervision of the Director of Music,
- Accompanies solo, guest, and substitute musicians,
- Provides weekly special music solos for services,
- Participates in special programs, such as the annual Sing Noel service.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Demonstrated piano skills.
- Evidence of ability to work with a wide range of people with varying degrees of musical talent and knowledge.

EDUCATION:

Formal education in piano is preferred. Experience may be substituted.

ADDITIONAL CERTIFICATIONS:

Applicant must comply with requirements of the Safe Congregation Policy prior to active employment, including background check.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

- Salary is competitive and includes a health care allowance
- Eligible for participation in UUA retirement plan
- In lieu of vacation, the pianist is permitted to miss one Sunday service and one weekly choir practice each calendar quarter.

JOB TYPE:

This is a task-based appointment expected to require, on average, approximately 10 hours per week.

COVID-19 CONSIDERATIONS:

All staff are vaccinated for COVID-19. Church is not meeting in-person for Sunday services at this time (services and other meetings are via Zoom). The Pianist participates in onsite broadcast of weekly service (mask must be worn, even if fully vaccinated).

ABILITY TO COMMUTE/RELOCATE:

Tulsa, OK 74133: Reliably commute or planning to relocate before starting work (Preferred)

EXPERIENCE:

Experience as a pianist in a church setting is preferred but not required.
