Christmas in July


Heifer International is a non-profit organization that aims to combat poverty and hunger worldwide. They work by providing livestock and agricultural training to families in need. The organization believes in the concept of "passing on the gift," where families receiving animals commit to passing on the offspring and knowledge to other families in their community. This sustainable approach helps create self-reliance and empowers communities to improve their economic situation and food security. Additionally, Heifer International supports various projects related to women's empowerment, education, and environmental sustainability to uplift communities and promote long-term development.

CYRE is hosting our second annual Christmas in July. The children choose what to buy for individuals in other countries. Last year we bought a sheep, an alpaca, a pig, a flock of chicks, bees, seedlings, and a share of a goat. The people are able to share the goat's milk in community.

I hope to continue this for many years and even found a certificate given to Hope for past donations.

Hope and Church of the Larger Fellowship co-hosted the Ordination of Steven Leigh Williams on July 2nd. Following the Ordination, Steven is moving to California to serve as the Interim Minister at the Palomar Unitarian Universalist Fellowship in Vista, California, and we wish him the very best!
